

KEO CITY COUNCIL MEETING

APRIL 22, 2024

Meeting started @ 7:01 PM

Those present: Mayor Stephanie White, Recorder/treasure Clara Hughes, Alderman: Dave Sharp, Randy Hudkins, Lynda Staton, and David Lanehart.

No Guests were present.

March Minutes was presented to the council after a discussion on these minutes a motion by Lanehart to approve the minutes and a 2nd by Sharp with all in agreement.

February 29th Special minutes were presented Sharp made the motion with a 2nd Staton with all in favor.

March 2024 financials was presented to the council after looking these over Sharp made a motion to accept these financials with a 2nd by Staton the motion passing unanimously.

March 2024 water financials was presented after a discussion on these financials a motion to accept these financials was made by Staton with a 2nd by Lanehart with all in agreement.

Mayor White presented to the council the monthly water report. Mayor White asks the council to consider cutting Account # 197 used 20,000 gallons cut in ½ 10,000, Acct# 3 used 20,180 ½ 10,090, Acct# 91 used 6830 ½ 3,415, Acct# 99 used 27,190 ½ 13,595 and Acct# 111 used 16,450 ½ 8,225 after presenting the accounts to the council Lynda Staton made the motion to cut the water portion in half for these accounts with a 2nd by Hudkins with all in favor.

Fire report was given by Fire Chief David Busick. The discussion to sell the fire safety house was discussed Lanehart made a motion to allow Fire Chief to sell the safety house for the price it was purchased with a 2nd by Staton with all in agreement.

Mosquito spraying company VDIC is offering Keo to consider using their services for this coming summer. Council said they would at least like to listen to see what the company is offering for the city.

No dog complaints for this month.

Mayor White asked the council to consider reallocating the remaining \$25,000 ARPA funds toward the pulling of the well and accessing & repairing & the amount to reallocate is \$ 11,776.00. The other portion of the \$25,000 is the 50/50 grant for the fire department for extrication equipment. After a discussion on this Lynda Steton made the motion to reallocate the funds 11,776 towards the well pulling & repairs, and 13,224 to go towards the 50/50 grant for the fire department for the extrication equipment with a 2nd by David Lanehart with all in agreement.

Upcoming city events: clean-up day April 27th, Fourth Friday Cruise to Keo April 26, 2024, & Dia del Nino April 30th.

A motion to adjourn at 8:15 PM was made by Lynda Steton with a 2nd by David Lanehart with all in agreement.
