Financial Statement for the City of Keo's Water & Sewer for October 2022 was reviewed by the council after looking these over Hudkins made a motion to accept these financials as presented with a 2nd by Lanehart and passed unanimously with one abstention.

The proposed budget for 2023 was presented to the council and after discussing Lanehart made a motion to accept the budget with corrections with a 2nd by Staton with all in agreement.

The amended 2022 budget was presented & after reviewing the budget Collins made a motion to accept the amended 2022 budget with a 2nd by Lanehart with all in favor.

Mayor White read the budget resolution for 2023 proposed budget after reading Hudkins made a motion to accept with a 2nd by Staton with all agreement.

Mayor White presented the mills and asked the council did they want to increase the mills this year, after a discussion Collins voted to raise the mills to .0016 from it .0011 with a 2^{nd} by Staton and all were in agreement.

Council discussed not having a December council meeting and the next council meeting would be January 23, 2023.

Hudkins made a motion to adjourn the council meeting at 9:10 PM with a 2^{nd} by Staton with all in agreement.
